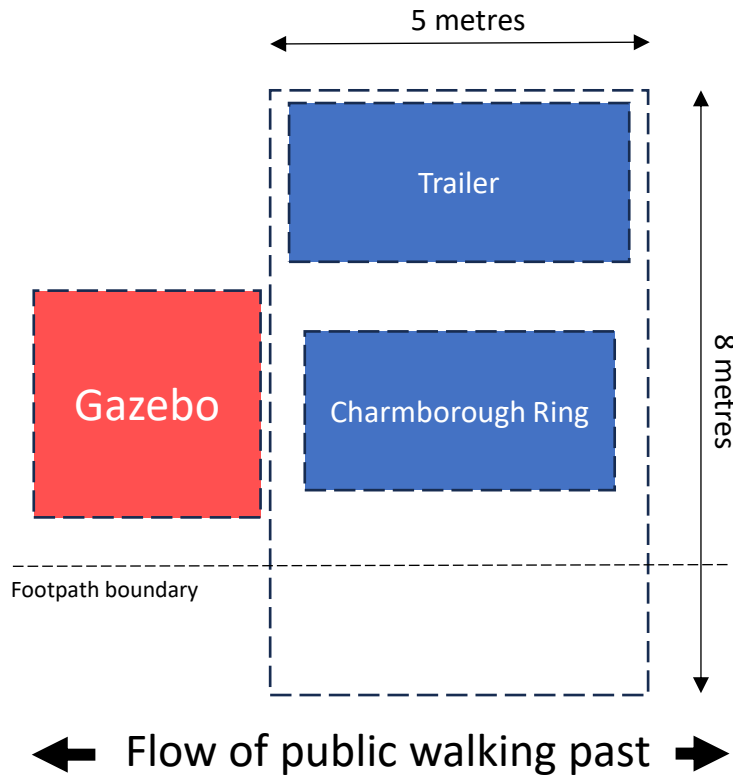


# The Charmborough Ring- space requirements

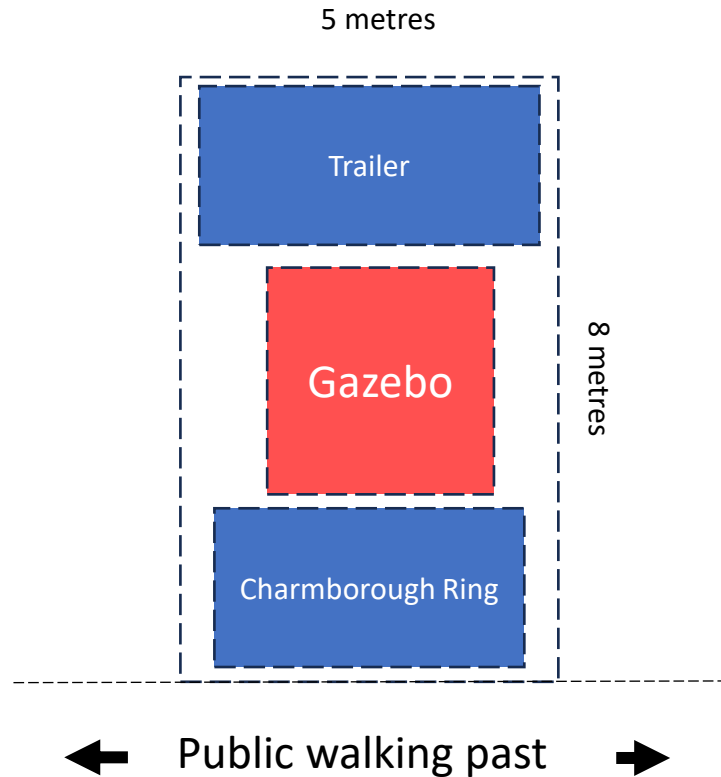


Once erected, the Charmborough Ring needs a space of about 4m x 2m and is 4.2 m high.

A space of at least 8m x 5m (shown dotted) is required to lay the ring out flat and erect it. Part of this space could be a path through the event, but this space will need to be clear of pedestrians whilst the ring is being set up and dismantled.

We also have a 3m x 3m pop up gazebo, to accommodate roller banners and other display material. Hirers may also wish to provide their own tables and chairs for the ringers. The gazebo can be erected to the side of the ring, as shown here, or behind. The advantage of this layout is that the public can more easily view material in the gazebo.

## Alternative layout



If there is no space available to the side, the ring can be set up as shown above with the gazebo behind the ring. Usually, it is possible to lay the legs out flat on the walkway during set up and dismantling, before the legs are raised/lowered. This only obstructs the path for about 5 – 10 minutes and comes near the beginning/end of the process. Alternatively, both legs can be assembled flat on the pitch, to one side of the ring, avoiding the need to temporarily obstruct the path.

The advantage of having the trailer on site is that it can be manhandled into position to raise/lower the bells, so allowing the tow vehicle to leave site at the beginning and come back at the end of the process.
